Be given a blanket extension to all EAC and ETAC accredited programmes by ONE (1) year, accreditation award from 2020 to 2021.</p> <p>Subject to submission of the programme previous SAR together with supplemental documents that address on how the IHL implement their TLA during MCO and to be transparent of its process.</p>	Only applies to accredited programmes.
New Programme /Defer	<p>Accreditation visit will be conducted between 1st July – 31st December 2020.</p> <p>In the event of a physical visit is not practical, and MCO is in effect, a virtual accreditation visit may be an option. Continuing	Continuing accreditation between March 2020 until December 2020 is subjected to a Desktop Review only. Any concerns that require further clarifications will be arranged through VC by the EAD & ETAD Secretariat.	Only to CLOSE CONCERN/S.

The visit will be conducted by only ONE (1) EP.</p> <p>In the event of a physical visit is not practical, and MCO is in effect, a virtual accreditation visit may be an option.
